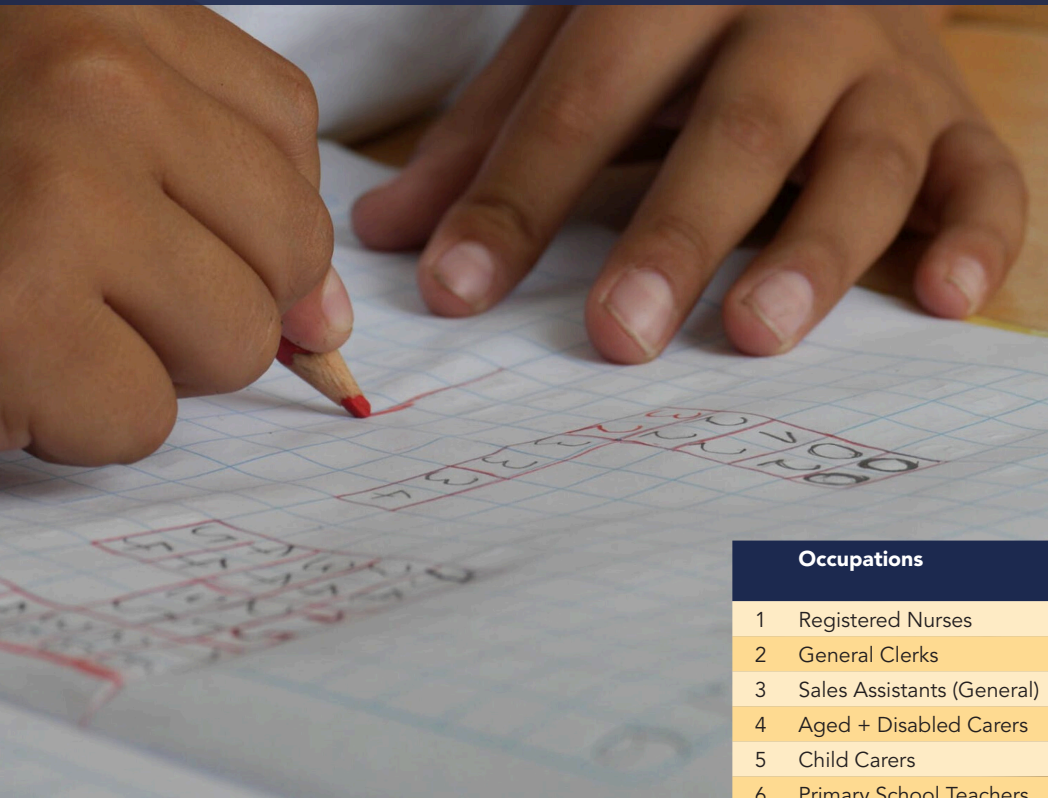




Top 10 Employment Occupations

Education Aide



Jobs Queensland was tasked by the Queensland Government to undertake research and provide advice on future skills needs. The Anticipating Future Skills project has updated a baseline scenario to 2024, based on the 2019 labour market, population and economic data and the Queensland Government's 2017-18 Budget papers.

Economic modelling produced data for industries, occupations, regions and qualifications, using Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) classification systems.
